- A professor with experience in a clinical setting
- A PhD, DNP, Clinical Fellowship/ Subspecialty in different clinical areas of specialty



- A minimum of a Master's degree (MMed), postgraduate studies in a medical field with at least 10 years of experience in the field their respective specialization
- A combined experience in hands-on teaching, clinical supervision, mentorship and research is required.
